A Voice in the Car

#2:

Driving home on a long trip from a speaking job, and nowhere near a service station, I heard a voice speaking. The voice, was speaking in my mind and it said, "Radiator. Your radiator needs water." But there was no

I took a small, empty plastic water bottle and filled it up at a water fountain near some picnic tables. I held the bottle tightly and could feel that the water was very cold. I guess if I've learned anything from some of my experiences over the years, it's that often that "small, still voice" we're supposed to listen to isn't so small and still! When that happens, it snaps you to attention and really makes you listen to it.

Do you have a ring, a watch or a key?

Long before I every started doing phone readings, I would meet individuals in a bookstore or coffee house. We would sit at a little table and I would ask for an object to feel .. something that might have energy. Most often used were a ring, watch, or keys. I would feel the objects and the reading would begin.

Once I was reading a man whose relationship had ended badly. He wanted answers and I had tried several objects, but none had enough energy. Then he asked if his credit card could be used. I held it in my hand and suddenly had all the energy I needed ... and then some! This was packed full of emotions he did not even realize he had felt, ranging from love to betrayal.

Every object that people have or use has an energy impression. Tap into that and you tap into real emotions: anger, fear, love, kindness. But I have found, after that experience, that the most powerful object to feel is a credit card.

This psychic technique is called psychometry...the feeling and reading of objects that carry psychic energy.
